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RE:NEW Co-Hosts Its First Concert “Fearless”

With Asian-American Artists AMP, Mickey Cho, Gowe, NAK, & MC Jin

ROWLAND HEIGHTS, Calif., Oct. 4, 2014 --- RE:NEW will co-host its first ever concert at Newsong Church in Irvine, California on Saturday, October 25, 7:00 p.m. The event will feature artists from the Fearless Tour: AMP, Mickey Cho, Gowe, NAK, and MC Jin. The Fearless Tour will be the first time these artists are coming together on the same stage, with the hope of exemplifying the idea of being fearless. Apart from their concert in Irvine, the Fearless Tour will be performing at other churches in northern California, Virginia and Maryland.

“It all started when I was in college and I heard the song ‘Never Alone’ by AMP,” said Phoebe Ng, RE:NEW project manager. “Years later, when RE:NEW was looking for potential artists to connect with, that song came back to mind so we reached out to AMP to be part of our magazine. After a few email exchanges and one interview later, AMP reached out to us about partnering together to help host what is now the Fearless Tour.”

RE:NEW had an [exclusive interview](#) with the artists from AMP in November 2013, where Chung Lee, J.Han, and Sam Ock shared about their musical backgrounds, inspirations, the songwriting process, and how they got the name AMP. Soon after, AMP asked RE:NEW to co-host the Fearless Tour concert in Irvine.

“We reached out to RE:NEW because not only did we have a similar mission, but seeing their ministry and the connection we already had, there was a sense of trust and like-mindedness,” said Chung Lee, CEO & Co-Founder of Good Fruit. “We felt RE:NEW could play a significant part in the tour. We were honored that RE:NEW agreed to be on-board and it has been nothing less than exceptional serving together with them!”

Among the various performers, AMP is a collective made up of East Coast artists CL, J.Han and Sam Ock, who seek to engage their culture through hip-hop with lyrical influences that are rooted in deep Christian tradition. Mickey Cho is a Bay Area hip-hop artist whose music is heavily influenced by his passion for Jesus and ending social injustice. Gowe is a hip-hop artist from Seattle, who believes that music is a great medium that can connect people of all different backgrounds and beliefs. NAK is a Christian rapper from Los Angeles who aims to increase

awareness of the many underlying spiritual afflictions that plague us all whilst speaking and performing the truth in holistic love. MC Jin is a Miami-raised hip-hop artist, television host and actor who was the first American solo rapper of East Asian descent to be signed to a major hip-hop record label; in 2009, he became a Christian and has since expressed his faith in his music.
